

The Lobby

A few steps up St-Pierre's street, the Lobby is the heart of the Phi Centre. It offers a spectacular view of the historic architecture and state-of-the-art design and technology that defines the Phi Centre. The Lobby is outfitted with a reception desk and is the gateway to the Theater, the Rhino, the Espace Plateau, and the stairs/elevator up to Spaces B, C, D. The space also offers a coat check area and accessible restrooms. The Lobby is equipped with a 4-screen digital display system available upon request and under certain conditions. Please speak with your appointed event coordinator for additional details.

The Rhino

Straight across from the Lobby and into the most strategic corner of the building, is the Rhino. A luminous salon with tall windows on both St-Paul and St-Pierre streets that offers a unique view of bustling Old Montreal. The space is outfitted with a permanent-install PA system and usually hosts a variety of "bistro" style tables and chairs as well as a roll-away bar. The Rhino's capacity is dictated by your events layout and furniture requirements. The Phi Centre will establish actual capacity on a case-by-case basis to ensure a pleasant and safe experience for our guests. The Rhino communicates directly with the Espace Plateau.

Space C / The Gallery

Space C, aka "the Gallery", offers vast wall space with a modular hanging system and a rail-mount lighting system for professional gallery installation. Long-term projects may use fake walls for wall-mounting pieces. A reception/information desk is installed right next to the elevator and steps leading up to Space C. Space C has a posted capacity of 266, however, that number needs to be coordinated with other events on the same floor. Refer to your appointed event coordinator to establish the actual capacity for your event.

The Terrace

With an incredible view over Old Montreal and unrivalled privacy, the Terrace offers a comfortable and genuinely relaxing atmosphere. Stairs in Grand Salon lead straight up to the intimate roof of Phi Center's historical building. The Terrace capacity is 49 and must be counted in the total occupancy of the floor below (Grand Salon).

Dimensions

Restrictions

The use of any and all type of fasteners (screws, nails, double-sided tape, etc.) is prohibited throughout the building. Since the Centre is classified as historic, the use of proscribed fasteners will result in reparation and restoration charges. The use of pyrotechnic effects, naked flames, confetti and sticker distribution are strictly forbidden at all times throughout the Phi Centre.

Loading/Unloading

Deliveries should be directed to the Evans Court alley on St-Paul street, right before the corner of St-Pierre. Cube trucks up to 16' can access the alley only. Any longer vehicles will need to unload from Saint-Paul street. All truck movements must be coordinated with the Technical Director. No vehicles may remain in the alley without its driver present at all times, as neighbouring residents and businesses rely on access to the alleyway. Vehicles must be parked off premises once unloaded.

Storage

There are no storage or staging areas at the Phi Centre for empty and dead cases. Storage must be achieved within the venue space or arranged off-premises. Please discuss this constraint with the Technical Director to avoid last minute fees and inconveniences. All deliveries and pick-ups must take place on the day of the event.

Hospitality

A green room and two dressing rooms are available on the 3rd floor, accessible either by the stairs or the elevator. These rooms are not exclusive to any venue and must be reserved ahead of time if needed. Please speak with your assigned event coordinator to ensure availability. Fees may apply.
