MUSEUM EXPERIENCES

In order to limit the capacity of our institutions, reservations for our exhibitions are made by time slot and our team will ensure that the capacity of each room on site is respected.

A plexiglass partition has been installed at our two reception counters where a physical distance of 2 meters was not possible.

Various stations with hydroalcoholic gel have been placed at the disposal of our visitors.

Exceptionally, there will be no access to the changing rooms by the public.

A traffic plan is available on our website and in the form of a poster at the reception desk.

Payment by card only (on site and online) - No cash.

CLEANING AND VENTILATION

- Every 30 to 45 minutes:
 - Cleaning of all door handles
 - Cleaning of all ramps

- Every hour:
 - Reception counters
 - Elevator
 - Bathrooms

- Cleaning staff on site from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday
- Complete cleaning and disinfection on nights from Monday to Friday.

- Ventilation filter (LEED, Gold building)
 - With regards to ventilation, the air filters in the main system have been replaced with 90% efficient filters.

REMOTE WORK (EMPLOYEES)

PHI prioritizes remote work so that the number of employees on site is kept to a bare minimum.

REDUCED MOBILITY
